DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Cheviot Rugby Football Club Incorporated for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 57 Ward Road, Cheviot and known as Cheviot Rugby Club

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is a private wedding function with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Friday 28 February 2020 from 4.00pm to 12.30am the following day. **The bar will close no later than 12.00am to allow for a 30 minute drink up time.**

The licensed area is designated as supervised and includes the interior licensed areas are:

- The clubrooms main hall and servery.
- The outdoor licensed areas will be the veranda, ramp and the concrete area between the clubrooms and the fence at the edge of the playing fields.

Cheviot Rugby Football Club Incorporated has held a club-licence since December 1994. The club has also held special licensed events both at the clubrooms and at Cheviot Showgrounds.

Cheviot Rugby Football Club Incorporated named two experienced duty managers for the event.

Julia Dickson has previous experience as a duty manager at the Cheviot Trust Hotel. She was issued a new manager's certificate in October 2018.

Annie Ashford has held a manager's certificate since August 2014 and has over 10 years' experience in the hospitality trade.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
