DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Hanmer Springs Golf Club Incorporated for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 133 Argelins Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Hanmer Springs Golf Club

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is 60th Birthday Celebration with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Friday 28 February 2020 from 7.00pm to 1.00am following day. The licensed area is undesignated and includes the interior of the golf club house and adjacent paved veranda area.

The bar will stop serving alcohol at 12.30am to allow for a drink-up time within the licensed hours.

The Hanmer Springs Golf Club has held a club-licence since 1995. The club has held previous special licences including darts tournaments in 2018 and 2019, a Christmas function for the Hanmer Pools staff, a funeral and birthday parties for a club members.

Gordon Simpson and Garry Ritsma are the proposed duty managers for the event. They are duty managers at the Hanmer Springs Golf Club.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
