**DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Georges Road Vineyard Partnership for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 651 Mt Brown Road, Broomfield and known as Georges Road Wines

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought for the “Miss Lily of Rangiora’ mystery bus tour for women with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Tuesday 18 February 2020 from 12.00 noon to 2.00pm. The licensed area is undesignated and is the tasting and barrel rooms.

**The service of wine will cease at 1.30pm to allow a 30-minute drink-up time.**

Georges Road Vineyard has operated a tasting room by appointment only since September 2016. The applicant has held previous special licences for events at the winery and for several years at the North Canterbury Wine and Food Festival.

Kirk Bray is the sole duty manager for the winery and has experience selling wine at the tasting room and at wine festival events. He has held a manager’s certificate since June 2016.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
