**DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Cheviot Rugby Football Club Incorporated for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 54P Seddon Street, Cheviot and known as Cheviot Showgrounds

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is Cheviot A&P Show with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being **Saturday 14 March 2020 from 12.00 noon to 7.00pm.**

**The bar will cease serving alcohol at 6.30pm to provide a 30-minute drink-up time.**

**The licensed areas** will include:

- **Supervised** – the public bar area in the marquee and adjacent fenced outdoor area.
- **Undesignated** – the Judges' area of the marquee and adjacent fenced outdoor area.

Trellis fencing at a height of 1.1 metres will be constructed to define the licensed areas.

The Cheviot Rugby Club holds a club–licence and has previously operated the licensed bar at the Cheviot Show.

The applicant has named two duty managers for this event:

**Anna-Louise Ashford (Annie)** has held a manager's certificate since August 2014 and has over 10 years' experience in the hospitality trade. Annie is a bar manager at the Cheviot Rugby Club.

**Julia Dickson** is a duty manager for the club. She has previously held a manager's certificate and has experience as a duty manager at the Cheviot Trust Hotel

In addition two staff with the assistance of security staff will be on duty at all times increasing in number during peak times.

The security staff will assist in monitoring patrons for escalating intoxication and will also be responsible for ensuring unaccompanied minors do not enter the 'supervised' area.

Intoxicated people will not be permitted entry, and proof of age identification will be checked.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
