DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Abby France on behalf of Hanmer Springs Fete for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 1 Jacks Pass Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Queen Mary Hospital Grounds. The on-site special licence is intended to cover the sale and supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises from the following vendors: The Queen Mary Bar; Ataahua Wines, Reefton Distilling Company; and Hanmer Springs Wines.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is the Hanmer Springs Fete with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Friday 30 October 2020 from 10.00am to 4.00pm. The licensed area is undesignated and includes a fenced off area of the Queen Mary Hospital lawn.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this event.

The licence may issue immediately.
