DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Amuri Squash Club for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 700 Iverachs Road, Waiau and known as Cranford Woolshed.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is Amuri Spring Ball with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 10 October 2020 from 7.00pm to 12.30am the following day. The licensed areas will be designated as 'restricted' and include:

- The Cranford Woolshed; and
- An outdoor area defined by straw bales as fencing.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this event. The applicant is granted an exemption to the requirement for a certified manager in accordance with s. 213(2) of the Act.

The licence may issue immediately.
