### **DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Abby France on behalf of Hanmer Springs Fete for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 1 Jacks Pass Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Queen Mary Grounds.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is Hanmer Springs Mid-Winter Fete with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being **Friday 02 July 2021** from **2.00pm to 8.30pm**. The licensed area is **Supervised** and includes **the paved area within the Queen Mary Hospital site**.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale of alcohol, to any person attending this event for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licence may issue immediately.
