DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Ataahua Wines Limited for an off-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 1 Jacks Pass Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Queen Mary Grounds.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is Hanmer springs Fete with the day and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being **Friday the 29th day of October 2021 from 10.00am to 4.00pm**. The licensed area is **Undesignated** and includes a **one-metre-wide area immediately in front of the stall**.

In their reports, the Police, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application. Due to COVID-19 the Medical Officer of Health reporting requirement was suspended.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an off- site special licence authorising the sale of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event (or series of occasions or events) for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licence may issue immediately.
