DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Ruahine Ports Limited for an off-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 1 Jacks Pass Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Queen Mary Grounds.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is the Hanmer Springs Fete with the day and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being **Friday 29th October 2021** from **10.00am to 4.00pm**. The licensed area is **undesignated** and will be a **one-metre-wide area immediately in front of the stall**.

In their reports, the Police and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application. The Medical Officer of Health has not reported due to COVID response commitments.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an off-site special licence authorising the sale of alcohol, to any person attending this event for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licence may issue immediately.
