DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by J M Ball & L A Ball for an off-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 67 Blacks Avenue, Glenmark and known as House of Ball.

The nature of the two events for which the licence is sought is the: **Papanui Wine Club Picnic** and the **Lotus Car Club Picnic** with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being **Sunday 21 November 2021** from **11.00am to 4.00pm** and **Saturday 19 February 2022** from **11.00am to 4.00pm**. The licensed area is **undesignated** and includes **outdoor areas adjacent to the house**.

In their reports, the Police, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application. The Medical Officer of Health did not report due to COVID-19 commitments.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an off- site special licence authorising the sale of alcohol, to any person attending these two events for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licence may issue immediately.
