DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Georges Road Vineyard Partnership for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 115 Glenmark Drive, Waipara and known as Weka Pass Railway.

The application was placed on hold due to postponement of the original date in September 2021 as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic and the New Zealand government restrictions on public events at the time. The applicant has now advised a postponement date for 2022.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is Train Trip with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Sunday 9 October 2022 from 11.30am to 3.30pm. The licensed areas will be undesignated and includes:

- The Glenmark Station and a defined area of the platform, and
- The Weka Pass Railway steam train, and
- A defined area of at the Waikari Train terminal.

In their reports, the Police and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application. The Medical Officer of Health did not report on the application due to their commitments during the COVID-19 pandemic.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this event.

The licence may issue immediately.
