DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Waikari Sheepdog Trial Club for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 31 Fergusons Road, Weka Pass and known as Red Oak Stud.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is Waikari Sheepdog Trials with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Friday 18 February 2022 from 11.00am to 11.00pm and Saturday 19 February 2022 from 11.00am to 11.00pm. The licensed area is undesignated and includes the woolshed and an adjacent fenced off outdoor area.

In their reports, the Police and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application. The Medical Officer of Health did not report on the application due to limited resourcing during the COVID-19 pandemic.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this event.

We grant the applicant an exemption from the requirement to have a certificate holding manager, pursuant to s. 213(2) of the Act.

The licence may issue immediately.
