DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Plains Motorcycle Club for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 3 Church Road, Glenmark and known as Glenmark Domain.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is Sundown Retreat Motorcycle Rally with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Friday 14 October 2022 from 12.00pm midday to 1.00am the following day, and Saturday 15 October 2022 from 11.00am to 2.00am the following day.

The licensed areas include:

- **Restricted Designation** – the bar gazebo
- **Supervised Designation** – the open field area of the Glenmark Domain (i.e., all areas except the bar).

In their reports, the Police and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application. The Medical Officer of Health did not report on the application due to their commitments during the COVID-19 pandemic.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this event.

The special licence may only issue once the Resource Consent RC220022 has been issued by the Hurunui District Council's Planning Team.
