**DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Amuri Collie Club for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 824 Hanmer Springs Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Lochiel Station.

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is Amuri Collie Club Sheep Dog Trials with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Thursday 31 March 2022 from 10.00am to 10.00pm and Friday 1 April 2022 from 10.00am to 10.00pm. The licensed area will be undesignated and includes:

- The Cookhouse and the bar buildings; and
- The adjacent roped off outdoor area.

In their reports, the Police and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application. The Medical Officer of Health did not report due to their commitments during the COVID-19 pandemic.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
