DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Abby France on behalf of Hanmer Springs Fete for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 1 Jacks Pass Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Queen Mary Grounds. The on-site special licence is intended to cover the sale and supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises from The Queen Mary Bar and acts as the overarching special licence for the event.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is Hanmer springs Fete with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Friday 28 October 2022 from 10.00am to 4.00pm. The licensed area is undesignated and includes the Chisholme Ward and Nurses Hostel areas of the Queen Mary Hospital site. The area will be fenced with temporary and existing permanent fencing.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
