DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Ruahine Ports Limited for an off-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 127 Ashworths Road, Amberley and known as Amberley House.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is Christmas Fete with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Thursday 27 October 2022 from 9.30am to 4.00pm. The licensed area is undesignated and includes a one-meter-wide area immediately in front of the stall.

The Christmas Country Fete Limited hold the overarching on-site special licence (57/SP/2197/2022) for the event. The applicant is required to adhere to the licence conditions of the overarching special licence and ensure that the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol is made in accordance with the Alcohol Management Plan.

As per the Alcohol Management Plan, the off-site sale of alcohol must be provided to the purchaser in a sealed bag and must not be opened or consumed at the event.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an off- site special licence authorising the sale of alcohol, to any person attending this event for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licence may issue immediately.
