DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Abby France on behalf of Hanmer Springs Fete for an overarching on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 3 Jacks Pass Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Queen Mary Grounds.

The event for which the licence is sought is Hanmer Springs Fete 2023 with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Friday 27 October 2023 from 10.00am to 4.00pm.

The licensed area is undesignated and is defined as “the Chisholm Ward and Nurses Hostel areas of the Queen Mary Hospital site. The area will be fenced with temporary and existing permanent fencing and clearly defined as the Hanmer Springs Fete venue.”

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this event

The licence may issue immediately and subject to the following conditions:

- a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
Friday 27 October 2023 from 10.00am to 4.00pm. Note: on-site sales of alcohol at the event must cease sales at 3.30pm to allow for a 30-minute drink-up period.
- b) No BYO alcohol is permitted at the event.
- c) The licensee shall take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:

- Signage must be displayed at all points of sale indicating the sale of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons is prohibited.
 - The licensed area is **undesignated** and is defined as “the Chisholm Ward and Nurses Hostel areas of the Queen Mary Hospital site. The area will be fenced with temporary and existing permanent fencing and clearly defined as the Hanmer Springs Fete venue.”
- d) The licensee must operate the event, in accordance with the Alcohol Management Plan, received by the Hurunui District Licensing Committee on 7 August 2023.
- e) The following alcohol outlets have been licensed to sell alcohol at and from the event (**i.e., on-site and off-site sales of alcohol**):
- Ataahua Wines Limited.
 - Reefton Distilling Co. Limited.
 - Justine Schroder for Mt Fyffe Distillery.
 - Aroha NZ Wines Limited.
- f) The following alcohol outlets have been licensed to sell alcohol at the event only (**i.e., on-site sales of alcohol**):
- The Alchemist Limited.
 - Inflatablez Limited.
 - Hanmer Springs Wines Limited.
- g) The following alcohol outlets have been licensed to sell alcohol from the event only (**i.e., off-site sales of alcohol**):
- Geraldine Distillery Limited.
 - Ruahine Ports Limited.
 - Gobsmackingly Good Limited.
- h) The licensee shall take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the management of premises are observed:
- The licensee has appointed Bobby Harpur to manage the overarching on-site sales of alcohol at the event. He will be present at all times while the licence is in force and is responsible for the implementation of the Alcohol Management Plan.
 - Signage must be displayed at all points of sale indicating the name of the manager on duty.
- i) Drinking water must be freely available at the following places while the premises are open for business.
- Four water station for drinking water and filling bottles located will be located throughout the venue, clearly advertised by signage. Each alcohol stall will also have free water available
- j) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when alcohol is available for sale as follows:
- 15 food vendors will be located at the two food areas at the event.
- k) Low alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply at the event.
- l) Non-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply at the event as follows:
- Soft drinks and juices.
- m) The licensee must take the following steps to provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises:
- Pre-event advertising will include messages about walking to the venue, and information is available on the Fete website.
