DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Anna Justine Schroder on behalf of Mt Fyffe Distillery for an on-site and off-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 1 Jacks Pass Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Queen Mary Grounds.

The event for which the licence is sought is Hanmer Springs Fete 2023 with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Friday 27 October 2023 from 10.00am to 4.00pm.

The licensed area is undesignated and includes a one-metre-wide area immediately in front of the stall. The event organiser, Abby France on behalf of the Hanmer Springs Fete, holds an overarching on-site special licence No. 57/SP/2289/2023, which allows customers to roam around the venue with their alcohol.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this event. We also grant the applicant an off- site special licence authorising the sale of alcohol, to any person attending this event for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.
