DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Seismic Cider Limited for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 63 Jacks Pass Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Hanmer Springs Domain.

The event for which the licence is sought is The Bandquet with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 23 March 2024 from 11.00am to 6.30pm. The licensed area is undesignated and includes "the fenced area within the Hanmer Springs Domain."

In their reports, the Medical Officer of Health and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

The New Zealand Police did not oppose the application, provided that the serve limit is reduced to two (2) drinks per person. The applicant was agreeable to this condition.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this event.

The licence may issue immediately, and is subject to the following conditions:

- a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
 - Saturday 23 March 2024 from 11.00am to 6.30pm. The sale and supply of alcohol must cease promptly at 5.30pm to allow for a drink-up period.
- b) Alcohol may be sold and supplied as follows:

- On-site sales: Seismic Cider branded cider (4.5% to 5.0% abv.) served in the branded glass.
- c) A serve limit of two (2) alcohol drinks per person, per transaction applies to this event.
- d) The licensee must comply with the Bandquet Stallholders Manual 2024 and the Alcohol Management Plan for the event, submitted and managed by Carter Consultants Limited (Special Licence No. 57/SP/2356/2024).
- e) The stall duty manager, or an experienced representative, must attend the compulsory pre-event briefing. The person must then conduct a briefing for their stall staff on the information provided at the briefing.
- f) Staff must check that the purchased is wearing the appropriate coloured wristband prior to completing any sale and supply of alcohol.
- g) The licensee shall take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - Signage must be displayed at all points of sale indicating the sale of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons is prohibited.
 - The licensed area is defined as "the fenced area within the Hanmer Springs Domain." The licensed area is undesignated.
- h) The licensee shall take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the management of premises are observed:
 - The licensee has appointed Kerry Payne to manage the premises and will be present at all times while the licence is in force.
 - Signage must be displayed at all points of sale indicating the name of the manager on duty.
- i) Drinking water must be freely available at the following places while the premises are open for business.
 - Free drinking water dispensing stations and cups will be located around the event and clearly advertised through signage.
 - Each stall is required to have drinking water freely available.
- j) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when alcohol is available for sale as follows:
 - From 8 food vendors, selling a range of meals and fast foods.
- k) Low alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply at the event.
- I) Non-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises as follows:
 - A range of soft-drinks, orange juice, water and tea and coffee will be available to purchase from the food vendors at the event.
- m) The licensee must take the following steps to provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises:
 - Ticketholders are encouraged to have a sober driver or walk to and from the event.
