We are in full support of - Relocating the carparks currently available in Gore Bay to the Cheviot Service Centre Carpark.

We also want to bring your attention to the number of trucks (large freight trucks), buses and campers that park and stay overnight in the lay-by on the northern end of the single lane Hurunui bridge on SH1.

We thought this may reduce once the trees had been harvested but it is still an ongoing practice. There are no facilities in the area to support individuals staying overnight. Surely truck drivers know of designated areas along their route of travel that accommodate day/night stop overs that fit with their driving hours.
