I am the owner of 7 Oregon Heights, Hanmer Springs.

This residential property is in the immediate vicinity of the proposed flyride.

I oppose the application for the following reasons:

- (1) The proximity of the flyride will have unacceptable adverse effects to members of the community who reside in this area and/or use the amenities at Conical Hill.
- (2) I am extremely concerned at the lack of consideration for suitable and adequate parking to accommodate persons who seek to use this adventure activity. In my experience as a long-term resident of this area, the roads are currently only just sufficient to cater for existing users (i.e. residents, their visitors and persons who seek to walk up Conical Hill to enjoy this lovely environment).
- (3) The proposed activity will generate additional and excess noise within an environment that is noted for its peaceful tranquility and natural amenity value.
- (4) I also have concerns about privacy and traffic congestion on public roads in the area.
- (5) My property is located on a private right of way (ROW) which is abeam the Conical Hill walkway. I am extremely concerned that persons using the flyride will park in our ROW and/or use our ROW as a (walking) short cut through to the public road at the top end of Oregon Heights.
- (6) My review of the application has given rise to a concern that it does not achieve the relevant objectives and policies of the Hurunui District Plan.
- (7) The proposal is inconsistent with the provisions of the Resource Management Plan.
