Together with my wife, we own the home at 18A Oregon Heights, one of the homes closest to the proposed 'Stop Station' and Tower 7. We are directly to the south and down hill from this part of the ride. As such we will be potentially affected by any noise associated with the final part of the ride, the construction of the stop station and tower 7, and any potential increase in number of cars seeking to park in our immediate vicinity.

We SUPPORT the proposed ride and in particular SUPPORT the NON provision of car parking associated with the ride. We believe the ride is very much in keeping with the adventure and outdoors nature of Hanmer. We do not believe that car parking will be an issue as almost all existing users of Conical Hill walk to the hill. Walking to activities is part of the existing mantra of Hanmer and we don't expect this to change. The proposed operating hours mitigate any adverse effects of increased noise in our view.
