We oppose the granting of the permit for the Flywire for the following reasons that directly affect the enjoyment of our property

Car parking - We have owned the property at No 1 Oregon Heights for 21 years. Our property is one of a few properties in Oregon Heights where cars can actually park outside our house. The majority of the houses on Oregon Heights are on 2 private roads that prohibit access & parking. Parking is very limited on Oregon Heights and the road is narrow in parts which further limits parking. As no car parking is being provided by the operator of the Flywire the roadway on Oregon Heights will become very congested from the anticipated riders parking to take the walk up Conical Hill. Street parking is heavily congested currently with many of the houses on Oregon Heights being rented by multiple families & friends.

Noise - We feel that the tranquility of the area will be affected from the noise of the riders yelling when they come to the end of the ride at the Stop Station. The riders need to also walk along an exposed track to rejoin The Conical Hill Walkway. Voices and noise are very noticeable in the quiet serene surroundings on Oregon Heights and carry great distances in this environment.

Visual Interference - The last 2 support poles and the stop station for the Flywire will be very visible in the exposed environment where they are to be located. The area is currently green and very bare of any plantings so the the poles and station will be highly visible. This area is visible from our property.
