Purchasing rubbish and recycling bags

Rubbish and recycling bags can be purchased at Waiau Hardware. Opening hours are Monday-Friday, 8.00am-5.00pm.

2

Do's and don'ts

No loose rubbish, glass bottles or ashes are to be dumped at the collection point.

HDC bags only.

3

Collection day

Rubbish and recycling bags are collected weekly on Monday. Make sure your bags are at the collection points around the village by 8am ready to be picked up – this day changes on public holidays and can be found on the Council website.

4

Do's and don'ts

Make sure your HDC bag is under 15kg, securely tied, and doesn't contain anything that could endanger staff, or damage the vehicle.

This includes animal waste, sharp objects and medical/hazardous waste.

5

Transfer Station Hours

Waiau Transfer Station is located at 116 Rotherham Road North. The transfer station opens on Monday, Wednesday and Saturday from 10am-midday. Out of hours recycling is provided for clean glass bottles with lids removed.

FOOD, DRINK & PET FOOD CANS

Plastic bottles and containers:

- Soft drinkbottles (no lids)
- A Milk bottles (no lids)
- Larger yoghurt and ice cream containers (no lids)

If there's no number, throw it out.



These items do NOT go into your kerbside Recycling Bag!

- ➤ Plastics numbered:
- Soft plastics i.e. any plastics that can be scrunched in your hand
- Plastic shopping bags and strapping
- HURUNUI District Council

- Tetrapaks
- Glass bottles
- Polystyrene and polystyrene meat trays
- Clothing and shoes
- Food or garden waste
